1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 1.2.2026 in connection with Chihra P.S.Case No.09/2026 registered for the offence U/s.98 of B.N.S. pending in the court of A.C.J.M.2nd,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Rajeev Kumar Sinha,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Lalita Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chihra Police Station alleging therein that on 31.1.2026 at 11 A.M. the petitioner came at the house of the informant and demanded some paddy which was given by the informant, and thereafter, the petitioner had kidnapped the daughter of the informant, but later on he was caught by the co-villagers and the daughter of the informant was handed over to the informant.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioner is mentally ill person and due to suspicion, the case was instituted by the informant who later on clarified the fact by filing a petition, which is annexed with the record. The petitioner has not moved any bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that though the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.but later on, it was found that the petitioner is mentally ill and due to misconception, the informant had filed a case against him, but later on, she

retracted her version by filing petition which is available on the record. The petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 1.2.2026.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be his close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of his bail bonds.**
