1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners who are in judicial custody since 12.2.2026 in connection with Jhajha P.S.Case No.53/2026 registered for the offence U/s.115(2), 126(2), 109, 303(2), 352 and 351(2) read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.
2. Heard Sri Zainul Abidin,the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P.for the State.
3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Tuntun Yadav has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Jhajha Police Station alleging therein that on 6.2.2026 at 6 P.M.while the informant alongwith his mother were going to market for purchasing some articles by the motorcycle,but in the mid way, two persons riding on the motorcycle intercepted them alongwith 5 unknown persons, and both accused pointed revolver on the ear-pit of the informant and they were identified by the informant as the petitioners, and it is further alleged that Nadeem Ansari pointed pistol and Sajid Ansari struck on the persons of the informant by iron rod, and thereafter, both have snatched Rs.20,000/-from the informant,and when mother of the informant intervene and protested, then she was also assaulted by them and her gold chain was also snatched by both the accused. The informant was also threatened for dire consequences if any informtion would be given to the police.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. It is further

submitted that earlier no any regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court. It is further submitted that the petitioners have clean antecedent and the case has been instituted due to road rage as it has come during investigation that due to minor dashing of the motorcycle of the petitioners with the informant's bike, the occurrence was happened, in which, the informant has got injured, and this fact has been categorically stated in para 42 of the case diary. Moreover, the injury inflicted to the informant side are simple in nature.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the occurrence was happened due to road rage and nature of injury inflicted to the informant is simple. The petitioners have clean antecedent and are languishing in judicial custody for more than one month.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioners must be their close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of their bail bonds.**
