This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 22.1.2026 in connection with Jamui P.S.Case No.657/2025 registered for the offence U/s.109, and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S.,and section 27 of the Arms Act pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Pardeep Mandal,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Mamta Kumari has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Jamui Police Station alleging therein that on 12.12.2025 at 8.10 a.m., she proceeded to attend the school, but after some time got information through mobile phone that there was firing at her home,and after getting this information she returned to her home and came to know from the shop keeper Sujit Kumar and others that one Rajpati Singh stated that while he was sitting at the shop, then three accused persons including the petitioner came there and started abusing and further fired from the gun and bullet struck in the pipe of the wash room of the house of the informant, and thereafter, all the three accused persons fled away.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner for firing bullet at the house of the informant, but neither any person got injury nor any damage was caused to the house of the informant.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the petitioner has four criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner for making firing at the house of the informant, but no any injury caused to any person or things. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody near about three months.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be his close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of his bail bonds.**
