1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners who are in judicial custody since 23.2.2026 in connection with Bichkorwa P.S.Case No.17/2026 registered for the offence U/s.190(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 118(1), 109, 127(2), 352 and 351(2) of B.N.S. pending in the court of A.C.J.M.2nd,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri A.K.Yadav,the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Manoj Yadav has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Bichkorwa Police Station alleging therein that on 22.2.2026 total seven accused persons as named in the F.I.R. including the petitioners assaulted to the informant and his cousin namely Ranjit Yadav by sword and Axe, consequently both have injured in the occurrence. It is further alleged that the informant got injury on his head and his cousin received internal injury. The accused persons also looted the articles of the shop of his cousin Ranjit Yadav.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners have not moved any other bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court except the present petition. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and there is no any overt act has been alleged against them. All the sections inserted in the F.I.R. are bailable in nature except section 109 of the B.N.S. which is super addition. There is case and counter case

between the parties regarding the occurrence. The nature of the injury of informant is simple which is mentioned in para 41 of the case diary and other persons injured in the occurrence.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that petitioner No.1 has two criminal antecedents, whereas, petitioner No.2 has one criminal antecedent, but petitioner No.3 has clean antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering the particular fact there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners for assaulting to the informant and nature of injury is simple, and petitioners are languishing in judicial custody for more than one month.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
