1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 25.1.2026 in connection with Bichkorwa P.S. Case No.81/2025 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115, 118(1), 117, 109, 74, 352, 351(2)(3) and 190 of B.N.S. pending in the court of the A.C.J.M.2nd,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Lakhan Lal Sharma, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sikar Marandi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Bichkorwa Police Station alleging therein that all the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioner having variously armed with lathi, axe and bow and arrow came at the field of the informant and started cutting the paddy crops of the informant, and when the informant protested, the accused Shyam Lal Marandi (petitioner) struck on head of the cousin of the informant namely Sadho Lal Marandi and when uncle of the informant came to save him, then he was also assaulted by the petitioner, consequently, his hand was got fractured. Other accused persons also assaulted the family members of the informant.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has clean antecedent. There is case and counter case between the parties regarding the occurrence, and all the injuries inflicted to informant side are simple in nature except one injury inflicted to Rashi Marandi which is grievous in nature, but the same is not on vital part of the body.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering the particular fact that there is case and counter case between the parties regarding the occurrence, and nature of all the injuries inflicted to the informant side are simple in nature except one which is not on vital part of the body, and the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody fore more than one months.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
