This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 24.2.2026 in connection with Chandradeep P.S.Case No.32/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 137(2), 96 and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of A.C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Makeswar Prasad Yadav,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Ashif khan has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chandradeep Police Station alleging therein that on 22.2.2026 at 5.15 a.m. his sister namely Anguri khatun went out of the house,and at the same time five accused persons as named in the F.I.R. kidnapped her with an intention to marriage. When the informant went to inquire about the where-about of his sister, then it is alleged that the accused Fulchand Paswan and Banti Paswan abused and assaulted him, and thereafter, the instant case was lodged.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the petitioner did not kidnap the sister of the informant, but she herself had gone to her relative house and on the same day she returned to her house. The victim has also denied the prosecution case in her statement recorded U/s.183 of the B.N.S.S. The petitioner has clean antecedent and earlier he has not moved any bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the victim is on the verge of majority

and she has not supported the prosecution case in her statement recorded U/s.183 of the B.N.S.S. and the petitioner has clean antecedent.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
