**INDRADEV YADAV & 3 Others VS. THE STATE OF BIHAR**  
**A.B.A. NO. - 313 Of 2026**

**ORDER**

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners **1. Indradev Yadav 2. Sintu Yadav@Situ Kumar, 3. Bhavani Yadav and 4. Lalo Yadav** who are apprehending arrest in Jhajha P.S. Case No. 514/2024 registered U/s-191(2), 190, 115(2), 110, 74, 332(C) 352, 351(2) of B.N.S. the copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P.

The ld. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. No any bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners u/s 482 or 483 of B.N.S.S. either in this ld. Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna except the present one. There is Jhajha P.S Case No. 512/2025 filed against the petitioner no. 1, 2 and 3, in which they are on bail. Petitioner no. 4 has got no criminal antecedent. The police has not given notice u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S to the petitioners. All sections are bailable in nature except Sections 110, 74 of BNS which are not applicable against the petitioners. The petitioners have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. The instant case is counter case of Jhajha P.S Case No. 516/2024. The petitioners are men of means, there is no chance of their absconding. They are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the ld. Court. In such view the ld. Counsel prayed to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail.

The ld. Addl. PP opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the case diary it is clear that that the petitioners are F.I.R. named accused. The prosecution case as per written information of informant Manju Devi is that on 11.11.2024 at about 7:00 PM, she was at her house when suddenly 01. Indradev Yadav, 02. Sintu Yadav, 03. Bhawani Yadav, 04. Chanoli Kumar, 05. Lalo Yadav entered her house with axes and rods in their hands, broke the lock of the box kept in the house and Indradev Yadav took away Rs. 25,000/-. When her and her two daughters protested against this, all the accused persons with wrong intentions started forcibly holding the private parts of her both daughters and her in an inappropriate manner. Sintu Yadav threw her elder daughter on the ground and tried to dishonor her forcibly and Indradev Yadav tried to press the chest of her younger daughter. Upon the objections, Bhawani Yadav opened her saree and tore her blouse and caught hold by her hair

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and threw her on the ground and started beating her. Upon the hue and cry nearby villager came to save them and then they fled away. She further told that Lalo Yadav snatched the gold chain from the neck of her elder daughter and Chanoli Kumar snatched the gold chain from the neck of her younger daughter. The informant in her re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras- 5, 6, 7, 8, 16, 17, 18, 19 have supported the incident. The injury report of Manju Devi in CD para-24 shows (i) Pain on shoulder, (ii) Pain chest body, all injuries have been found to be simple in nature by the doctor. In CD para-24 the SDPO has found the case as true against the petitioners but Section 74 BNS does not appear to be applicable from the testimony of the witnesses. In CD para-63 there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner no. 4 but in CD para-64 there is one criminal case against the petitioner no. 1, 2 and 3. The Court finds that as per the witnesses no ingredients of offence u/s 74 BNS is available in the to the case diary. There is case and counter case. There is land dispute between both parties. The simple injury does not correspond to attraction of Section 110 BNS.

Accordingly in such view this anticipatory bail stands **allowed**. The petitioners **1. Indradev Yadav 2. Sintu Yadav@Situ Kumar, 3. Bhavani Yadav and 4. Lalo Yadav** in the event of their arrest or surrender are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.
