1. Heard both sides on the bail petition dated 19.7.2022 filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Suma Devi who is in custody since 2.12.2021 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.215/2013 U/s. 147, 148, 149, 120B, and 307 I.P.C., section 3/4 of Explosive Substance Act, section 27 of Arms Act, and section 16, 17, 18, and 20 of U.A.P. Act pending before this court vide S.T.No. 159/2022.

2. Perused the records, and case diary. It appears that the prayer for anticipatory bail of this accused/petitioner has been rejected by this court vide ABP.No.296/2014 dated 25.8.2014, and thereafter, this accused/petitioner has moved before the Hon'ble Court vide Cr.Misc.No.2238/2015 dated 20.1.2015, and the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to grant anticipatory bail to this accused/petitioner with a direction to surrender before the court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.215/2013 subject to the conditions as mentioned in the said order of the Hon'ble Court. It has been argued on behalf of the petitioner that the pairvikar has not given information to the petitioner regarding grant of anticipatory bail, and due to which, she could not surrender before the court below within time, and when she came to know about the proceeding of the case, she voluntarily surrendered before the court of C.J.M.Jamui on 2.12.2021, and since then, this petitioner, who is female, is languishing in jail custody.

3. Since, this accused/petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble Court, but she could not surrender before the court below within time stipulated by the Hon'ble Court, and when she came to know about proceeding of the case, this petitioner who is female has surrendered before the court below on 2.12.2021, and since then, she is languishing in jail custody, hence, she is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of this court subject to the conditions that (1) one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner, and other shall be the uncle of the

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petitioner namely **Dugan Manjhi**. The bailors will also undertake to inform the court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner, **(ii)** That the affidavit shall clearly state that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case, and if she is, she shall not be released on bail, **(iii)** That the bailor shall also state on affidavit that she will inform the court concerned if the petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after her release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse, **(iv)** That the petitioner will give an undertaking that she will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if she fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, her bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse, **(v)** That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if she fails to do so on two consecutive dates, her bail will be liable to be cancelled.
