1. The present Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioners namely, **1. Sunil Kumar & 2. Mannu Kumar @ Monu Kumar** who are in judicial custody since 26.02.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 69/2026, U/s 317(5), 3(5) of B.N.S., is hereby disposed of.

2. The Prosecution case as per FIR in brief is that the Informant-Sanni Kumari, S.H.O. Khaira P.S. on dated 25.02.2026 at about 20:30 hours during patrolling duty saw a motorcycle was coming from Jamui side and on seeing the police, the passengers/riders tried to run away but there were apprehended by the police. It is further alleged that on being asked as to papers of motorcycle, the riding persons, namely, Sunil Kumar and Mannu Kumar failed to produce valid document of the motorcycle and during interrogation it was confessed to be stolen motorcycle. Thereafter, the police seized the motorcycle after preparing seizure-list.

3. It was submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna except the present one.

4. It is further submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence. Further submitted that they have been falsely implicated in this case due to misunderstanding and suspicion and also the petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. It is, therefore, prayed to grant Regular Bail Petition to the accused-petitioners.

5. On the other hand, Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. On perusal, it reflects that the case has been registered at the instant of informant-Sanni Kumari, S.H.O. Khaira P.S. It is alleged that the police recovered a stolen motorcycle rode by the accused-petitioners. Para 33 of the CD reflects that the police failed to found the true owner of the seized motorcycle. Further, in para 30 of the CD, it is mentioned that the petitioners are carrying clean antecedent. Moreover, the petitioners are in judicial custody since 26.02.2026.

7. Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances and mainly considering the custody period of the petitioners, a lenient approach can be taken for the petitioner's prayer of Regular Bail. Accordingly, the Regular Bail Petition of the following, the accused-petitioners, namely, **1. Sunil Kumar & 2. Mannu Kumar @ Monu Kumar**, is hereby **Allowed**. They are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/-with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the condition that, one of the bailor must be **father or mother** and other bailor must be a **public servant**.

8. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
