1. This Regular bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely **1. Baiju Yadav, 2. Chano Yadav**. This bail petition is filed in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 440/2020, lodged U/s – 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504, 506 of I.P.C., Act. Copy of bail petition has been earlier supplied to prosecution.

2. The prosecution case in brief according to the informant is that on 10.10.2020 at about 04:00 p.m. Baiju Yadav was grazing his buffalo near his field. One of his buffalo entered the informant field and was eating his paddy crop. When the informant saw that buffalos are eating his paddy crop then he said the accused that his buffalo is eating his paddy crop so, informant requested the accused to kindly move it away. At this time Baiju Yadav become furious and started abusing the informant. When the informant asked him not to do so he struck the informant on his with a stick(lathi). The informant sustained internal injury to his head. Then, informant reach Baiju's Yadav brother Anko Yadav as well as Channo Yadav and Nitish Yadav regarding this event then, they came from there house armed with Iron rod and stick. Then, all the aforementioned individual surrounded the informant and began beating the informant with an intention to kill. As a result both the informant's leg are severely injured after that the informant was admitted to Khaira Hospital for treatment. During the assault the aforementioned individuals also snatched informant Mobile phone and Rs. 70,000/- in cash that the informant was carrying. On the basis of the fardbeyan the present F.I.R. was registered.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that besides the instant case no other criminal proceedings and no other bail applications of instant nature has earlier been filed on behalf of the petitioners mentioned hereinabove either before this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is submitted that accused-petitioner is lying in Jail custody since 25-02-2026.

4. On the other hand, Learned Add. P.P vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

5. Heard both the Ld. Counsel and perused the material on record from perusal of record it transpires that the present bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused Baiju Yadav, and Chano Yadav, who has been in custody since 25-02-2026, as there is specific allegation against the petitioner/accused of assaulting the informant. While the injury report of the informant Bholu Kumar Thakur is mentioned in the case diary. All the injury sustained by the informant is simple in nature. While the fact that the petitioner/accused is in custody for more than one month. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances, nature of allegation, the role played by the accused/petitioner. This court is inclined to grant bail to the accused/petitioner. Thus, the present Bail application for applicants namely **1. Baiju Yadav, 2. Chano Yadav** is hereby **allowed** on furnishing a Bail bond in a sum of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction to the Ld. Trial Court subject to the condition that that one of the bailors should be blood relative or co-villager of the petitioner and the petitioner/accused shall cooperate in the investigation and not temper the evidence or influence the witnesses.
