1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners who are in judicial custody since 7.2.2026 in connection with Chandramandih P.S.Case No.107/2023 registered for the offence U/s.394 of the I.P.C. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.
2. Heard Sri Sanjay Kumar Singh,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.
3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Dhiraj Kumar Mathuri has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chandramandih Police Station alleging therein that on 9.6.2023 at about 8 P.M.in the evening while the informant was returning from Madhopur market after closing his shop alongwith his cousin Shashikant Kumar and as soon as they reached near village Dhamaniya saw that one person after putting a trunk of a tree across the road has blocked the road, as a result, the informant stopped his motorcycle ,suddenly two persons came from behind and have started to assault the informant as well as his cousin Shashikant Kumar with lathi. Having receiving the injury, informant as well as his brother fell down on the ground and thereafter, one of the person who was tall after putting the informant on gun point snatched away his bag in which, informant was carrying laptop alongwith three mobile phones, two finger print devices and cash of Rs. 2 lakhs and fled away towards forest. On the basis of aforesaid information, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation was started.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners are not named in the F.I.R.,and their name surfaced in the case on the basis of

confessional statement of co-accused which has no evidenciary value in the eye of law. No any incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Both the petitioners have clean antecedent. Moreover, other co-accused person have been granted regular bail by this court after submission of charge sheet, and investigation against the petitioners are still continuing.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the petitioners are not named in the F.I.R. and their name surfaced in the case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, who have been granted bail in this case after submission of charge sheet but investigation against the petitioners is still pending.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that bail bond of the petitioners shall be accepted after submission of charge sheet/final report against the petitioners.**
