This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 4.3.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.86/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 351(2) and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Manager Pandey, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sangita Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Khaira Police Station alleging therein that on 3.3.2026 the F.I.R.named total eight accused persons including the petitioner came at the house of the informant having lashed with stick, lathi, and iron rod and started abusing the informant and further referred the informant as Daain. It is further alleged that the accused Niranjn Kumar pull down the hair of the informant and also struck on her head by iron rod, consequently she got injury and fell down on the earth. Thereafter, the informant started crying, then her husband and daughter came in her rescue, then they were also assaulted by the accused persons.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation of any overt act alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is happens to be a woman having clean antecedent. It is further submitted that earlier no any regular or anticipatory bail has been filed either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering the particular fact that earlier the case diary was called for by this court, but the same was not produced by the State even after giving last chance,thereafter, the matter has been taken up for hearing on the basis of materials available on record. From perusal of record,it appears that there is no specific allegation of any overt act has been alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is a woman having clean antecedent and she is languishing in judicial custody since 4.3.2026.

Hence,in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
