1. This is an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Jhajha P.S.Case No.63/2026 registered for the offence U/s. 190, 191(1), 115(2), 126(2), 117(1), 109, and 326(1) of the B.N.S., pending in the court of the C.J.M., Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Safdar Ali, the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Md. Tamjih Alam has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Jhajha Police Station alleging therein that he has a refreshment shop, and as per his daily routine, the informant and his father were going to open their shop. In the mean time, total nine accused persons as named in the F.I.R. having lashed with stick, lathi, sword and other weapons intercepted them, and started abusing and assaulting them, and when on the alarm made by them, the younger brother of the informant namely Tansil came there to save the informant, then the accused persons also assaulted him. It is specifically alleged that the accused Md. Nawab caught hold him, thereafter Md. Wasim (petitioner) gave a sword blow on his head. Thereafter, petitioner Shamsa khatun also assaulted him by iron rod. Thereafter, the accused Md. Safik brought a pistol from his house and handed over to the accused Nawab who assaulted the informant by the 'Butt' of the pistol. It is lastly alleged that after some time, another brother of the informant and sister-in-law came on the place of the occurrence, but both were also assaulted by the accused persons. Md. Wasim and Md. Safik struck on the head of his sister-in-law Rukhsana khatun by sword and they also outraged her modesty, and due to the assault, the informant and his

other family members were got injured and referred to the sadar hospital for treatment. It is also alleged that the Auto of the informant was also put on fire by the petitioner Md. Wasim during the occurrence.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The injury inflicted to the informant and others are simple in nature. In this case, other co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by this court vide an order dated 24.3.2026 passed in B.A.No.135/2026.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that petitioner No.3 Md. Wasim has one criminal antecedent, whereas, petitioner Nos.1,2, and 4 have clean antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering the particular fact that in this case, other co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by this court, and injury inflicted to the informant and others are simple in nature.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from the date of the order on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down U/s.482(2) of the B.N.S.S. **with further conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioners must be their close relative, and petitioners shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of their bail bonds.**
