This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners **1. Somar Das, 2. Din Dayal Das, 3. Rohit Das @ Rohit Kumar, 4. Chait Lal Das @ Chetlal Kumar, 5. Deventi Devi, 6. Kanti Kumari, 7. Nandkishor Das, 8. Girija Devi, 9. Rekha Devi, 10. Kishor Das and 11. Bholiya Devi** who are apprehending arrest in Bichchakorwa P.S. Case No. 36/2025 registered U/s-126(2), 115, 117, 109, 352, 351(2) (3), 3(5) B.N.S. the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. No other bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners u/s 482 or 483 of B.N.S.S. either in this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna except the present one. The petitioners have got one criminal case vide Bichchakorwa P.S Case No. 34/2025 and 1161C/2013 in which they are on bail. The Police has not given notice u/s- 35(3) of BNSS to the petitioners. All sections are bailable except section 109(1), 117 of BNS which are super added. The petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty politics. The petitioner Deventi Devi has filed a case vide Bichchakorwa P.S Case No. 33/2025 against the informant and others. The petitioners are persons of means, there is no chance of their absconding. They are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail.

The Id. Addl. PP opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the case diary it is clear that that the petitioners are F.I.R. named accused persons. The prosecution case as per written information of Ugani Devi is that on 28.06.2025 at 7:30 in the morning, her elder daughter-in-law was standing at the door. Somar Das took her bricks. Upon her objections, Somar Das having kudal in his hand with intention to kill assaulted at the right hand of her elder daughter-in-law, causing cut and it started bleeding. After that Co-accused Din Dayal having kudal with intention to kill assaulted her elder daughter-in-law. Rohit Das, Chaitlal Das, Deventi Devi, Kanti Kumari, Nand Kishor Das, Giraja Devi, Bholiya Devi, Rekha Devi and Kishor Das abused them and

assaulted with kick and punches. Prior to this incident the informant had given the application against the above accused persons before the P.S. Then the accused persons threatened her. After that her elder daughter in law was treated upon at Deoghar. The informant in her re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras-6 and 7 have supported the incident. While the independent witnesses and injured witness in CD paras-80, 86 and 140 also supported the incident. As per injury report of Asho Devi in CD para-26 there is (1) L/w on Right and left hand (ii) Bleeding, (iii) Vomiting tendency and (iv) Back Pain, opinion is reserved. After the injury report from Referral Hospital Chakai in CD para-127 fracture of radius of left forearm and radius & Ulna of right forearm, injury is grievous. The Court finds that the allegation against the petitioners is general and omnibus. There is land dispute between the parties. There is case and counter case. Five of the petitioners are females. The injury at best corresponds to Section 117(2) BNS.

Therefore in view of the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submission of both parties, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**. The petitioners **1. Somar Das, 2. Din Dayal Das, 3. Rohit Das @ Rohit Kumar, 4. Chait Lal Das @ Chetlal Kumar, 5. Deventi Devi, 6. Kanti Kumari, 7. Nandkishor Das, 8. Girija Devi, 9. Rekha Devi, 10. Kishor Das and 11. Bholiya Devi** in the event of their arrest or surrender are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.
