1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners who are in judicial custody since 4.3.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.87/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 351(2) and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Shyamdeo Singh, the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Babita Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Khaira Police Station alleging therein that on 3.3.2026 at 8 p.m, when the informant was taking dinner at her house alongwith her family, then all of a sudden, nine accused persons as named in the F.I.R. having lashed with iron rod, stick and Axe came at her house and started abusing the informant and when the informant protested, then it is further alleged that accused Prahlad Yadav struck on the head of the informant by iron rod and petitioner Karu Yadav has also assaulted her by iron rod which causes injury on her cheek and teeth. Co-accused Ramdeo Yadav referred the informant as Daain, and when younger son of the informant namely Niranjan Kumar came in her rescue, then accused Nirpat Yadv assaulted him by iron rod, consequently, he got injury upon his head. Other accused persons also participated in the occurrence.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation of any overt act of assault against the petitioner No.1.,but there is allegation of assault by iron rod against the petitioner No.2, but the injury

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inflicted to the informant and her son are simple in nature. The petitioners have clean antecedent. It is further submitted that earlier the petitioners have not moved any bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that there is no any specific allegation of assault against the petitioner No.1., and though there is allegation of assault by iron rod against the petitioner No.2, but the injury inflicted to the informant and her son are simple in nature. The petitioners have clean antecedent.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
