This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners who are in judicial custody since 12.3.2025 in connection with Charkapathar P.S.Case No.35/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2),118(1),109(1), 352, and 351(2) read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the A.C.J.M.,2nd,Jamui.
2. Heard Sri Manager Pandey,the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P.for the State.
3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Kheman Yadav has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Charkapathar Police Station alleging therein that on 10.3.2026 when he was sitting in front of his house, then all of a sudden, four accused persons including the petitioners came there having variously armed with lathi, Axe and iron rod and started abusing the informant. It is further alleged that the accused Naresh Yadav struck on the head of the informant by means of Axe while another accused Chanchal Yadav caught hold him from behind. It is lastly alleged that the accused Dharam Yadav instigated for committing the offence and co-accused Paro Devi assaulted him by means of bricks and stones.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The informant has amicably settled his grievance with the accused persons by way of a written compromise which is annexed with the bail petition. Moreover, the petitioners have not moved any bail petition either before this court or before the Hon'ble Court
5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that both the parties have amicably settled their grievance by way of a written compromise and the informant appeared before this court and does not oppose the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
