1. This is an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Chandramandih P.S.Case No. 190/2025 registered for the offence U/s. 115(2), 126(2), 132, 118(1), 117(2), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M., Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Nand Kishore Yadav, the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Nitish Kumar has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chandramandih Police Station alleging therein that presently he is posted as Vanpal in Madhopur forest area. It is further alleged that on 6.10.2025 at 10.30 a.m. when he was going to Bisanpur forest for patrolling and while he was returning, then four accused persons on two bikes including petitioners assaulted them from behind and consequently they fell down by the side of NH-333, and thereafter, the co-accused Rambilas Paswan and petitioner Ajay Paswan assaulted him with iron rod and stick and petitioner Bappi Paswan and co-accused Mohan Paswan assaulted to Dharendra Kumar by sticks, fists and slaps and during that accused Rambilas Paswan and Ajit Paswan took out Rs.10,000/- from the pocket of the informant and another accused also took out of Rs.8000/- from the pocket of Dharendra Kumar and they were forcibly got them sit on their bike and proceeded towards Lodhma forest with intention to kill them, but any how they fled away from their custody. Thereafter, both were treated in referral hospital, Chakai.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is general and

omnibus allegation against the petitioners and no any specific overt act has been alleged against any of the petitioners. The injury as alleged by the informant is simple in nature. Petitioner, Ajay Paswan has one criminal antecedent vide Chandramandih P.S. Case No.92/2024, in which, he is on bail. The other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide order dated 16.12.2025 passed in A.B.P. No. 1713/2025.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that petitioner No.1 has one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail and petitioner no. 2 has clean antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and further considering the nature of injury as stated aforesaid, and the fact that the allegation is general and omnibus in nature, and no any specific allegation of assault has been made against any of the petitioners.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from date of the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down U/s.482(2) of the B.N.S.S.with further conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioners must be their close relative, and petitioners shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of their bail bonds.
