1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 19.3.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.52/2024 registered for the offence U/s.392 of the I.P.C. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Rajeev Kumar Sinha,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Vijay Kumar who is a group loan officer in R.B.L. FINSERVE LTD, Sono Branch has lodged the instant case alleging therein that on 06.12.2024 at about 12:10 P.M. in the afternoon when the informant after collecting a sum of Rs. 20,860/- from village Dhiyatari was returning to his office, in the mean time, in the way, three boys have stopped him and on gun point snatched the bag, in which, a tab, one mobile phone, the key of his bike along with sum of Rs. 20,860/- were kept. It is alleged that the accused persons after snatching the bag have ran away towards the village Sarebad. Thus, on the basis of aforesaid information, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation was started.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in F.I.R.and his name surfaced in the case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused person namely Rahul Kumar which has no any evidenciary value in the eye of law. No any incriminating article has been recovered from possession of the petitioner and the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 19.3.2026. Moreover, similarly situated other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this court vide an order dated 9.12.2024 passed in B.A.No.923/2024 with B.A.No.939/2024.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and his name surfaced in the case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Rahul Kumar and later on, after arrest, the confessional statement of the petitioner was also recorded, in which, he categorically confessed his involvement in the commission of the offence, but the confessional statement has no any evidenciary value in the eye of law. Moreover, other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this court as stated aforesaid, and the case of the petitioner is on similar footing.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be his close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of his bail bonds.**
