This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners 1. **Sarita Kumari**, 2. **Krishna Devi**, 3. **Ranjeet Ravidas**, 4. **Ganesh Das** and 5. **Shakuntala Devi** who are apprehending arrest in Mohanpur P.S. Case No-34/2026 registered U/s- 126(2), 329(4), 352, 109, 115(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S, the copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P.

The ld. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. No other bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners either in this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That except this case Mohanpur P.S Case No. 12/2026 against the petitioners Sarita Kumari, Ganesh Das, Ashish Das, Mohanpur P.S Case No. 22/2026, Laxmipur P.S Case No. 63/17 against Ranjeet Ravidas and Krishna Devi and Laxmipur P.S Case No. 352/20 against Ganesh Das is pending in which they all are on on bail. The Police has not given notice u/s-35(3) of B.N.S.S to the petitioners. The present case is counter case of Mohanpur P.S. Case No.-35/2026. The petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. Section 109 of BNS is not made out against the petitioners. The petitioners are persons of means, there is no chance of their absconding. They are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the ld. Court. In such view the ld. Counsel prayed to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail.

The ld. Addl. PP opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the case diary it is clear that the petitioners are F.I.R. named accused persons. The prosecution case as per written information of Nitish Kumar, the Mohanpur P.S. Case No- 34/2026 was registered u/s-126(2), 329(4), 352, 109, 115(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S, wherein he has stated that on 22.03.2026 at 04:00 PM, he was sitting at home with his wife and children when his aunt, Sarita Devi, a fake teacher, started abusing him and asked as to why he had filed an application for verification of a fake certificate against her at the District Education Officer, Jamui. She abused him. Upon his wife's objections, from the adjacent room, Ravindra Kumar Das with intention to kill, assaulted at his head with sword. Thereafter Ranjeet Kumar Das having rod in his hand assaulted him at his head due to which he fell down and became unconscious. His wife started crying and shouted, then Ravindra Kumar Das caught his wife and dragged her upto 20 meters, due to which her saree was torn. The accused Sarita Kumari, Sanjay Ravidas, Rajan Das, Sakuntala Devi, Ganesh Das, Krishna Devi they all threw his mother on the

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ground and assaulted her also. Meanwhile, his mother saw Ashish Das having pistol in his hand was ready to commit major incident. Upon the hue and cry of the villagers, the accused persons fled away. In Course of fleeing, the accused Rajan Ravidas snatched gold necklace of his mother Sabita Devi. The informant in his re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras-6 and 7 has supported the incident. The injury report of informant Nitish Kumar in CD para-71 there is (1) Sharp cutting wound on head(Parietal region left side size 1.5inchx1/6"x1/5", (ii) Swelling with pain on chest size 1½"x3/4", all injuries are simple in nature. While X-ray of chest PA view show no any bony lesion, CT Scan Brain-No significant parenchymal abnormality detected. The Court finds that there is allegation against the petitioner Ranjeet Kumar Das that he assaulted at the head of informant Nitish Kumar with iron-rod. There is no corresponding injury. There is only one injury at the head of Nitish Kumar which is by sharp cutting weapon. There is general and omnibus allegation of assault against rest of the petitioners with no specific and overt act directed against them. Both parties are co-shares(pattidar) having land dispute. There is case and counter case. The petitioners Ranjeet Ravidas, Ganesh Das and Shakuntala Devi are injured in the counter case.

Therefore in view of the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submission of both parties, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**. The petitioners **1. Sarita Kumari, 2. Krishna Devi, 3. Ranjeet Ravidas, 4. Ganesh Das and 5. Shakuntala Devi** in the event of their arrest or surrender are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.
