	<u>25.05.2026</u>	Applicant Suresh Manjhi is present in the court and has filed hazari. Ld. Advocate on behalf of O.P. No. 3 & 4 Sri Ram General Insurance Company Limited is present in the court and has filed hazri. On behalf of O.P. No. 3 & 4 Sri Ram General Insurance Company Limited, Ld. Advocate Sri Harishchandra Sinha submits that he is having instruction to settle the dispute with the applicant for amount Rs. 5,00,000/-. It is further submitted that the applicant is also ready to settle the dispute for the aforesaid amount and both the sides have entered into amicable settlement and filed compromise petition before the court. It is accordingly prayed to dispose the matter in the light of settelement. Ld. Advocate on behalf of applicant Suresh Manjhi submits that his client is ready to accept the offer proposed by the insurance company as the applicant Suresh Manjhi has also entered into	

<u>Contd...</u> <u>25.05.2026</u>	compromise with O.P. 3 & 4. It is therefore prayed to pass order in the light of said compromise petition. Heard both the sides. Perused the case record. This case has been brought by applicants namely Jalava Devi and Suresh Manjhi against four opponents/O.Ps. It further reflects that during course of proceeding, the court vide order dated 23.05.2025 deleted the name of one applicant Jalava Devi because of her death and only applicant namely Suresh Manjhi is remained on record. It further reflects that applicant and O.P. 3 & 4 have submitted a joint compromise petition in which the applicant is ready to settle the dispute for Rs. 5,00,000/-. It further reflects that the submitted compromise petition is duly signed by both the parties and affidavited by the applicant Suresh Manjhi. Considering the facts as aforesaid, the compromise petition and the fact that the applicant and O.P. 3 & 4 have voluntarily entered into compromise to settle the dispute, I find it just and appropriate to direct O.P. 3 & 4 to submit cheque of settlement amount i.e., Rs. 5,00,000/- in favour of the

Further on being submission of the cheque, the O/C is directed to hand over the cheque to the applicant namely Suresh Manjhi after proper verification. Further on being failure to submit the settelement amount via cheque within aforesaid stipulated period, the applicant shall be at liberty to take appropriate course of law against the O.P. 3 & 4 for the violation of the order. In the light of aforesaid, the instant case stands disposed of. Office is directed to give a copy of this order to the Ld. Counsel of O.P. 3 & 4 for compliance. Ordered accordingly. Dictated Addl.
