PANCHA DEVI VS. THE STATE OF BIHAR

This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Pancha Devi** who is in custody since 26.03.2026 in connection with Laxmipur P.S. Case No. 275/2025 registered U/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 351(2), 303(2), 74 B.N.S, the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the custody accused has submitted that the accused is rotting in jail since 26.03.2026. Earlier the petitioners filed A.B.A 1740/2025 but the same was rejected by ADJ-VII, Jamui, regular bail petition was rejected on 02.04.2026 by Miss Manisha Kumari, J.M Ist Class, Jamui and after that no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner in any other Court except the present one. The petitioner has got two criminal cases which has been disposed off before Lok Adalat on the basis of compromise. The police has not given notice u/s- 35(3) of BNSS. As per Id. Counsel the petitioner is innocent has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute between the parties. The petitioner Pancha Devi is an old lady unfit to move. Earlier the husband Indradev Bind of petitioner had lodged Laxmipur P.S Cae No. 252/2025 against son of the informant and others. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner who is in jail without any reason. The petitioner is lady of means and there is no chance of her absconding and she is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Id. Addl.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of case diary it is clear that on the basis of written information of Sunita Devi the Laxmipur P.S. Case No. 275/2025 was registered U/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 351(2), 303(2), 74 B.N.S wherein she has stated that on 27.10.2025 at 03:30 P.M, her son Nawal Kumar Bind was going to the market to buy something, meanwhile all the FIR named accused persons caught her son and tied him with the pole and started assaulting him with Lathi, stick, fist and punches with intention to kill him. Upon hulla, when she came to save him, the accused Indradeo Bind, Manish Bind and Mirtunjay Bind assaulted her with axe due to which she sustained head injury and it started bleeding. She became unconscious and fell down on the ground but accused persons kept on assaulting her with kicks and punches. During

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assault someone had snatched 5gm gold Mangalsutra. When her daughter-in-law came there to rescue the informant and her son, all the accused persons assaulted her also with Lathi and Stick and accused Indradeo Bind broken her right hand by hitting her with Lathi. The accused persons also threatened her that if she lodged the case they would kill her and her family members. The informant in her re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The injured witnesses in CD paras-4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 have supported the case of prosecution. The injury report of Sunita Devi(informant) in CD para-30 is (1) Lacerated Wound on head (left parietal region size 1"x1/5"x1/4", (ii) Abrasion at Right Thumb, (iii) Pain and swelling at left wrist joint size 2"x1½", all injury are simple in nature. While as per injury report of Nawal Kumar shows (1) Pain in left shoulder size 2½"x2", (ii) Pain in right leg, (iii) Bruise on left Buttock size 1½"x1", all injuries are simple in nature While the injuries of Babita Devi are also simple in nature. The Court finds that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is found to be general and omnibus with no specific and overt act attributed against her. There is case and counter case between the parties. The petitioner is female who is in custody since 26.03.2026.

Therefore considering the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submissions advanced by both the parties, the custody accused **Pancha Devi** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
