1. This application relates with extension of period of surrender.
2. Heard both sides and also perused the record.
3. It appears that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the learned court of DASJ-VII, Jamui vide order dated 23.7.2025 passed in **A.B.A.No. 1028/2025** arising out of **Chandradeep P.S.Case No.185/2024** pending in the court of the A.C.J.M.1st, Jamui with the direction as mentioned in the order. But it has been argued that in fact the petitioner is suffering from chronic disease and due to some unavoidable circumstances, the petitioner could not appear/surrender before learned court below within time. Hence, a prayer has been made that for the ends of justice, the period of surrender of the petitioner may be extended, so that he may appear/surrender before learned court below and file his bail bond in the case.
4. For the ends of justice, I think it proper to allow the prayer for extension of period of surrender of the petitioner for a **further period of two weeks**, and, accordingly, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the court **within two weeks from the date of order** subject to the conditions that petitioner will deposit a cost of **Rs.1000/- in Victim Compensation Fund, D.L.S.A.Jamui** and file receipt of the same before learned court below at the time of surrender in the court.
5. Accordingly, this application is allowed. Let, a copy of this order be sent to the court of **A.C.J.M.1st, Jamui** in connection with **Chandradeep P.S.Case No.185/2024**.
6. Let, a copy of this order be also sent to the **Secretary, D.L.S.A.Jamui** in connection with **Chandradeep P.S.Case No.185/2024**.
