1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 3.4.2026 in connection with Jhajha P.S.Case No.87/2026 registered for the offence U/s.115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 352 and 109 of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Sitaram Singh,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sinku Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Jhajha Police Station alleging therein that on 28.2.2026 in the night, one Santosh Yadav barged into the house of the informant and tried to outrage her modesty and also assaulted her, and when the informant made alarm, then her husband Pankaj Yadav and mother-in-law Enwa Devi came there for saving the informant, but in the mean time, other accused persons namely Subhash Yadav, Kapil Yadav, Anil Yadav, Ranjan Yadav and Bodhn Yadav (petitioner) having lashed with iron rod and stick came there and they started assaulting the informant and her husband. It is specifically alleged against Santosh Yadav that he struck on the head of the husband of the informant by iron rod and other accused persons also assaulted to the informant by lathi and stick,whereby hand of the informant was broken. The mother-in-law of the informant also got injury on her hand and her gold chain was snatched by the accused Santosh Yadav. The informant and his family members were saved when local people came there after hearing the noise. It is lastly alleged that the accused persons snatched Rs.5000/-from the husband of the informant.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is general and

omnibus allegation against the petitioner, and no any specific overt act has been alleged against him. The petitioner has clean antecedent, and he is languishing in judicial custody since 3.4.2026 without any specific allegation against him.

5. The learned P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the informant Sinku Devi has got two injuries, and out of that, one injury is grievous in nature, though, it is not on the vital part of the body. Similarly, mother-in-law of the informant Enwa Devi has also got four injuries, and out of that, one injury is grievous in nature, though the same is not on vital part of the body.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner. Moreover, the petitioner has clean antecedent.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
