This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 10.4.2026 in connection with Barhat P.S.Case No.44/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, and 351(2) read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Sitaram Singh,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Ruka Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Barhat Police Station alleging therein that there is land dispute between the petitioner and the informant, and due to that on 8.4.2026, the petitioner alongwith other co-accused persons assaulted the informant on her head, consequently she got injured.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent, but there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and there is no any specific overt act of assault has been alleged against him.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner,and there is no any specific overt act of assault has been alleged against him.
