SONU KUMAR VS. THE STATE OF BIHAR

This regular bail petition has been filed by petitioner **Sonu Kumar @ Sonu Kahar** who is in custody since 24.03.2026 in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 72/2026 registered u/s-87, 140(3), 142 of B.N.S, the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the custody accused has submitted that the accused is rotting in jail since 24.03.2026. The regular bail petition was rejected on 15.04.2026 by Sri Kumar Shashi, J.M Ist Class, Jamui and after that no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner in any other Court except the present one. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. As per Id. Counsel the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case merely on suspicion. No ingredient of sections 87, 140(3), 142 of BNS are applicable against the petitioner because age of victim is 18 years as per FIR and she had gone outside from her house due to anguish over parent's scolding. The petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding and he is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Id. Addl.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of LCR and case diary it is clear that on the basis of written information of Anil Sah, the Sikandra P.S. Case No. 72/2026 was registered u/s- 87, 140(3), 142 of B.N.S, wherein he has stated that on 10.03.2026 at about 7:00 in the evening, his daughter Anisha Kumari aged about 18 years, went out from the house without any information, she did not return. Upon search she could not be found. On 11.03.2026 at about 8:00 in the morning, he got information that Sonu Kahar of village Bahadurpur, PS-Lachhuar, has kidnapped his daughter for the purpose of marriage. When he called over the mobile number 7397499421 of Sonu Kahar it was switched off. He got information from G.R.P.F that Sonu Kahar along with his daughter went to Hawra Railway Station (Kolkatta). The informant in his re-

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statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras-7 and 8 have supported the case of prosecution. As the per CD para-13 the victim Anisha Kumari in her statement u/s-183 of BNSS recorded on 23.04.2026 has stated that she had affair with Sonu and wanted to marry him. Due to upset by her parent's scolding she got angry and went to Kolkata by train from her house. She stayed for some days at Kolkata. After that she came to Jamui but out of fear of her father she again on her own went to Katihar to her friends. When she received information that his family was very worried about her and had filed a missing person's case at Sikandra P.S. she returned from Katihar. It is also clear from victim's statement u/s-183 of BNSS that nobody kidnapped her, she went from her house voluntarily and on her own. She is major. No offence appears to be made out. The petitioner is in jail since 24.03.2026.

Therefore considering the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submissions advanced by both the parties, the custody accused **Sonu Kumar @ Sonu Kahar** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
