1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by the accused-petitioners, namely, **1. Sonali Kumari & 2. Kailash Das**, in connection with Jamui Mahila P.S. Case No. 13/2026, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 110, 85, 3(5) of B.N.S. Act, is hereby disposed of.

2. The case of prosecution in brief is that the informant-Babita Kumari married to Vikash Kumar in the year 2013 and thereafter went to her Sasural wherein the in-laws of the informant continuously tortured her in connection with the demand of dowry and later on some amount were paid by her father. It is further alleged that on 06.04.2026, the accused including the petitioner have beaten her by which she sustained head injury.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioners that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna, except to it.

4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and has been falsely implicated. The petitioners have not got criminal history. No notice under Section 35(3) of B.N.S.S., 2023 was served upon the petitioners. Further submitted that the informant is living separately with her husband since 2016 and as such the petitioners had nothing to do with the informant.

5. On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P. opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. As alleged in the FIR that the informant was married to Vikash Kumar in the year 2013 and the case has been registered after 13 years of marriage. Further, the

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police had submitted injury report in the diary wherein the doctor found only pain and swelling and bruise and nature of injury opined as simple. Further, the petitioners are relative of the informant and not the husband. Further as submitted the petitioners are carrying clean antecedent.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to petitioner's prayer and accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, namely, **1. Sonali Kumari & 2. Kailash Das**, is hereby **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and, subject to the conditions that, **one of the bailor should be family member/villager.**

9. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
