1. The present Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely, **Mukesh Yadav**, who is in judicial custody since 24.01.2026 in connection with Charkapathar P.S. Case No. 143/2025, U/s 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and Section 25(1-b)a, 26, 35, 27 of Arms Act is hereby disposed of.

2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 27.12.2025 at about 06:00 p.m. accused-Pankaj Yadav came to the house of informant and said to her husband namely Lakhan Yadav that Manoj Hasda and others are waiting for party meeting and then he taken away her husband on motorcycle. It is further alleged that after passing of half an hour, villagers told her about firing and and she reached near the house of Jagarnath Rana at Baratand village then she found her husband lying on the ground covered with blood and died. It is further alleged that when she asked Jagarnath Rana with respect to the incident then he said that Manoj Hasda and others have murdered her husband by indiscriminate firing.

3. It was submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna except the present one.

4. It was also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Further submitted that the petitioner is not named accused in this case and he is having three criminal antecedent as Sono Charkapathar P.S. Case No. 342/20, Govindpur P.S. Case No. 199/2022 and Chakai P.S. Case No. 154/2021 besides this case. Further submitted that there is no any specific allegation against the petitioner to commit murder of Lakhan Yadav. It is, therefore, prayed to grant Regular Bail to the accused-petitioner.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. It

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reflects that the case has been instituted at the instance of Arti Devi, wife of the deceased Lakhan Yadav. The informant in her restatement and the witnesses in their respective statements have supported the case of the prosecution. Para 8 of the CD is the search and seizure memo wherein the police found ammunition and other articles at the place of occurrence. Para 12 of the CD is the place of occurrence which also supports the case. Para 13 of the CD is statement of Jagannath Rana who claims to have seen the alleged occurrence and stated as to active involvement of the petitioner in this case. Para 17 of the CD is the statement of Karu Yadav who had also supported the case. Further co-accused Manoj Hasda had taken name of the petitioner as accused in his confessional statement which reflects from para 146 of the CD. Further there is specific and direct allegation of firing against the petitioner. Moreover, Para 58 of the CD reflects that the petitioner is having several criminal antecedents.

7. Therefore, considering the seriousness alleged occurrence and specific and direct allegation and also recovery of incriminating articles from the place of occurrence, this Court is of the view that it is not a fit case to grant privileges of bail to the accused-petitioner, at this stage.

8. Consequently, the Regular Bail prayer of the present petitioner-**Mukesh Yadav**, is hereby **Rejected**.
