1. This is an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner apprehending his arrest in **Jamui P.S. Case No.179/2026, U/s. 135 of the Electricity Act,** pending in the court of Sri. Ahshan Rasid, J.M. 1st class, Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Nawal Kishor Sha the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. It appears that during raid conducted by the officials of Electricity Department, petitioner was found that there is no electricity Connection in this house, and without Connection and authority petitioner was using Electric and damage at the petitioner's residential premises and thereby, petitioner had caused total loss amount of **Rs.2,21,843/-** (Two Lakh Twenty one thousand eight hundred forty-three) to the **South Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited.**

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that in similar nature of the case,earlier this court has granted anticipatory bail to so many persons directing the accused to deposit 25% of total loss amount in the light of the order of the Hon'ble Court passed in Cr.Misc.No. 36211/2010, the petitioner is also ready to deposit 25% of total loss amount,and also ready to compound the case before the compounding authority.

5. The learned P.P.has also admitted that earlier this court has granted anticipatory bail to so many persons in similar nature of the case.

6. Since,the petitioner is ready to deposit 25% of total loss amount to the **South Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited,** and,further, petitioner is also ready to compound the case before compounding board. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to deposit 25% of total loss amount

suffered by **South Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited** through bank draft or in cash in favour of **South Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited** through court. Therefore subject to payment of aforesaid amount of 25%, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing **bail bond of Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the conditions as laid down U/s.482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. The petitioner is also directed to place his case before compounding board within a period of 45 days from today, and in proof of this, petitioner would file copy of compounding petition and their appearance before compounding board, before learned court below and if petitioner has failed-to-do-so, learned court below will be at liberty to pass appropriate order in accordance with law.
