1. This Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely **Sahil Khan @ Md. Sahil Khan**. This bail petition is filed in connection with P.S- Chandradeep, P.S. Case No. 199/2025, lodged U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 352, 3(5) of B.N.S. Copy of bail petition has been earlier supplied to prosecution.

2. The prosecution case in brief is alleging therein that on 14.11.2025 at about 2:00 p.m. as per the informant Konain Khan stated that on the way of house Sahil Khan and Sameer Khan pulled her Dupatta and misbehave with her by holding her hand with wrong intention. Upon hearing this the informant came out of his house and protest. Then Sameer Khan said that he like informant sister and want to get married with him after that Sahil Khan started beating the informant. Sameer Khan called his men with weapons and Asif Khan hit his brother Jaish Khan on the head with an Axe with the intention of kill due to which he fell on the ground with severe injuries, while he was lying down, Sahil Khan and Sameer Khan beat his brother Jaish Khan. His brother Fariyad Khan who came to save me was injured by Arsh Alam, and Chotu Khan by assaulting him with sharp weapon and sticks. When she tried to save him. Arsh Khan hit me on the forehead with a sharp weapon which injured her. On this people and villagers saved the lives of all three of us injured admitted to Aliganj Hospital from where the seriously injured Jaish Khan was referred to Sadar Hospital Jamui. Hence, this FIR registered against him.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that besides the instant case no other criminal proceedings and no other bail applications of instant nature has earlier been filed on behalf of the petitioners mentioned hereinabove either before this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and they have committed no offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case.

4. On the other hand, Learned Add. P.P vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

5. Heard both the Ld. Counsel and peruse the material on record including the F.I.R and L.C.R. From perusal of the record it transpires that F.I.R have been registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 352, 3(5) of B.N.S, 2023., the allegation against the accused/petitioner is that the petitioner alongwith Sameer Khan has tried to outrage the modesty of 14 years girl. Also there is allegation against the petitioner that he has assaulted the brother of informant Jaish Khan with a Garasha. The injury report of Jaish Khan is mentioned in para 49 of the case diary. The investigation in this case is still pending. The petitioner is in custody since 27.04.2026 that is more than one months. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of allegation, the role played by the accused petitioner. This court is inclined to grant the bail application. Thus, the present bail application for applicant namely **Sahil Khan @ Md. Sahil Khan** is hereby **allowed** on furnishing a Bail bond in a sum of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction to the Ld. Trial Court subject to the condition that that one of the bailors should be blood relative or co-villager of the petitioner and the petitioner/accused shall co-operate in the investigation and not temper the evidence or influence the witnesses and shall remain physically present on each and everyday till framing of the charge and on failure to do so on three consecutive date without reasonable cause. Their bail bond shall liable to cancelled.
