1. This Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely **1. Amit Kumar**. This bail petition is filed in connection with Chakai P.S case No. 57/2026, lodged U/s- 318(4), 61(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2) of B.N.S. Copy of bail petition has been earlier supplied to prosecution.

2. The prosecution case in brief is that a F.I.R register regarding recruitment from in personation and cheating at UCO Bank. IBPS advertise for clerical post and candidate were required to pass both prelims and mains examination. Following the IBPS the written exam UCO Bank issue an appointment letter to the petitioner on 07.08.2021, the petitioner joined the Chakai Branch, Dist- Jamui on 25.08.2021 and began receive his salary. IBPS received report of malpractices concerning appointment made between 2020-2024 were candidates allegedly used forged document and unfair means. In response IBPS reviewed the Data Bio-metric records of suspected candidates working across different banks. The petitioner was summons for reverification of his bio-metric instead of appearing, the petitioner stopped attending his duty at Chakai Branch indicating that someone else had originally taken the Bio-metric and appear in exam in this place. Subsequently completed authority officially terminated Amit Kumar from Bank service on 07.02.2026. Subsequently FIR was registered.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that besides the instant case no other criminal proceedings and no other bail applications of instant nature has earlier been filed on behalf of the petitioners mentioned hereinabove either before this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent. He has committed no offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case.

4. On the other hand, Learned Add. P.P vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

5. Heard both the Ld. Counsel and peruse the material on

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record including the F.I.R, Case diary. On perusal of the record it transpires that the F.I.R was registered u/s- 318(4), 61(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2) of B.N.S. against the petitioner. Petitioner was posted in UCO, Bank since 07.08.2021. The petitioner was summons for reverification of his bio-metric instead of appearing, the petitioner stopped attending his duty at Chakai Branch indicating that someone else had originally taken the Bio-metric and appear in exam in this place. The independent witnesses mentioned in paras 4, 5, 6 duly supported the prosecution case. The investigation in this case is still pending. Thus considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of allegation against the petitioner this court is not inclined to grant extraordinary relief of the petitioner. Thus the present Anticipatory Bail application for applicant namely **Amit Kumar** is hereby **rejected**.
