1. This Regular bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely 1. **Parshuram Yadav**, 2. **Bablu Yadav @ Bablu Kumar**. This bail petition is filed in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 175/2026, lodged U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 352, 109(1), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S., Act. Copy of bail petition has been earlier supplied to prosecution.

2. The prosecution case in brief is as per the statement of the informant Ghotar Yadav which was recorded at a private clinic is that on 18.04.2026 at approximately 10:00 a.m. the accused persons (total 12 named individuals) arrived at his house armed with saw, sticks and iron rods. It is alleged that upon informants protest against the destruction of his property the accused Chandradeo Yadav's wife Manju Devi attack the informant with an Axe, and his son Praveen Yadav struck him on the waist with an Iron rod, causing a fracture. Informant was subsequently hospitalized. On the basis of the fardbeyan the present F.I.R. was registered.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the accused is innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. It is argued that 12 people are named in the FIR, the allegations are general and omnibus in nature. The petitioner undertakes to abide by all court conditions and co-operate with the ongoing investigation. Also besides the instant case no other criminal proceedings and no other bail applications of instant nature has earlier been filed on behalf of the petitioners mentioned hereinabove either before this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court.

4. On the other hand, Learned Addl. P.P. vehemently opposed the bail prayer and submitted to reject the same.

5. Heard both the Ld. Counsel and perused the material on record from perusal of record it transpires that the allegations suggest specific overt acts by Praveen Yadav (hitting with an Iron rod) and Manju Devi hitting with an Axe. However regarding the petitioner there is no specific allegation against them the allegations appear to be being members of unlawful assembly without specific allegations against them. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances,

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nature of allegation, the role played by the accused/petitioner. The period of custody undergone by the accused. This court is inclined to grant bail to the accused/petitioners. Thus, the present Bail application for applicants namely 1. **Parshuram Yadav, 2. Bablu Yadav @ Bablu Kumar** is hereby **allowed** on furnishing a Bail bond in a sum of Rs. 10,000 with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction to the Ld. Trial Court subject to the condition that one of the bailors should be blood relative or co-villager of the petitioner and

(i) The petitioner shall regularly appear before the trial court on each and every date fixed.

(ii) The petitioner shall not influence witnesses or temper with the evidence.

(iii) The petitioner shall co-operate with the police in the investigation as and when required.

(iv) If the petitioner is found involved in any similar criminal activity in the future, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
