This regular bail petition has been filed by petitioners **1. Sofendra Yadav, 2. Kundan Kumar, 3. Sudhir Yadav and 4. Gopal Yadav** who are in custody since 30.04.2026 in connection with Chandradeep P.S. Case No. 78/2026 registered u/s- 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 74 of B.N.S, the copy of which is served upon the ld. P.P.

The ld. Counsel for the custody accused persons has submitted that the petitioners are rotting in jail since 30.04.2026. The regular bail petition was rejected on 05.05.2026 by ld. A.C.J.M-Ist, Jamui and after that no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners in any other Court except the present one. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. The allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and concocted. As per ld. Counsel the petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Prior Bhuneshwar Yadav father of petitioner Sofendra Yadav lodged a case against the informant vide Chandradeep P.S case No. 44/2026. After that Sofendra Yadav has lodged case against the informant Triloki Yadav and others as Chandradeep P.S Case No. 79/2026. There is case and counter. The petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding and they are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of ld. Court. In such view the ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

The ld. Addl.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of case diary it is clear that on the basis of written information of Triloki Yadav, the Chandradeep P.S. Case No. 78/2026 was registered u/s- 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 74 of B.N.S, wherein he has stated that on 28.04.2026 at about 8:00 in the evening, his daughter-in-law Rita Devi was going from one house to another house when suddenly thirteen persons started teasing his daughter-in-law. Upon the hue and cry, he came to save her but the

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accused person assaulted him with iron rod and his brother Rito Yadav also sustained injuries. They snatched golden chain from the neck of his daughter-in-law. The accused persons Abdhesh Yadav, Sukondar Yadav, Sudhir Yadav, Kundan Yadav, Gopal Yadav, Surendar Yadav, Ramvilash Yadav, Kashi Yadav, Lalan Kumar, Vipin Yadav, Sunny Kumar, Rajkumar Yadav, Bhuneshwar Yadav were involved in this incident. The informant in his re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras-3, 4, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34 have supported the case of prosecution. The Court finds that there occurred free fight between both parties and both parties sustained injuries. The Court also finds that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. The allegation against the petitioners is found to be general and omnibus with no specific and overt act attributed against them. There is case and counter case between the parties. Injury report is not available in the case diary. As per CD-39 there is no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are in custody since 30.04.2026. The offence u/s-74 of BNSS is superaddition.

Therefore considering the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submissions advanced by both the parties, the custody accused **1. Sofendra Yadav, 2. Kundan Kumar, 3. Sudhir Yadav and 4. Gopal Yadav** are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
