1. The present Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely, **Yashoda Devi**, in connection with Bichkorwa P.S. Case No. 27/2026, U/s 126(2), 115, 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5), 103 of B.N.S., is hereby disposed of.

2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that Bichkorwa P.S. Case No. 27 of 2026, dated 15.03.2026 was instituted under Section 126(2), 115, 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and later on Section 103 B.N.S. was added alleging therein that due to land and house construction dispute, the accused persons assaulted the informant and his father by means of lathi, axe and sword causing injury to the father of informant who subsequently died during treatment. The name of the present petitioner has also been implicated in the said occurrence.

3. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no other bail petition except the present one has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner before any Court of law.

4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case due to family and land dispute. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Further, Sections 126(2), 115, 352 and 351(2) of B.N.S. are bailable in nature and Sections 109 and 103 of B.N.S. are not at all applicable against this petitioner in the facts and circumstances of the present case. It is also submitted that the specific allegation of causing fatal injury by deadly weapon is mainly against co-accused persons and no specific overt act causing injury has been attributed against the present petitioner. The petitioner is a lady and has been implicated only on account of relationship with the co-accused persons.

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5. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. On perusal of record, it reflects that the informant in his re-statement and the witnesses in their respective statements have supported the case of the prosecution as reflects from para 2, 5, 6, 25, 26, 27, 28 of the case-diary. Further, para 4 and 24 of the case-diary is the place of occurrence and para 7 of the case-diary is the picture of the injured namely Jagarnath Yadav now deceased which also supports the case. Further, para 37 of the case-diary is the death certificate of Jagarnath Yadav which reflects that the injured died in the course of treatment of the injury sustained in the alleged occurrence. Further, para 86 of the CD is the post-mortem report wherein the doctor found injuries on the body of deceased namely Jagarnath Yadav and found the injuries are antemortem in nature and caused by hard and blunt substance. Further, the allegation against the petitioner is direct and serious in nature. Moreover, the case against the petitioner is under investigation and more facts are yet to come before the Court.

7. Therefore, considering the seriousness of alleged occurrence and also specific and direct allegation against the petitioner, this Court is of the view that it is not a fit case to grant privileges of pre-arrest bail to the accused-petitioner.

8. Consequently, the Anticipatory Bail prayer of the present petitioner-**Yashoda Devi**, is hereby **Rejected**.
