This is an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner apprehending her arrest in connection with Chandradeep P.S.Case No.83/2026 registered for the offence U/s.115(2), 126(2), 329(4), 109, 74, 351(2) and 352 read with 3(5) of the B.N.S.pending in the court of the A.C.J.M.1st, Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Makeshwar Prasad Yadav, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sarojni Devi has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Chandradeep Police Station alleging therein that on 5.5.2026 when she was at her home along with her child, then all of sudden, two persons entered into her house and started abusing her daughter namely Nisha Kumari and also assaulted her by means of iron rod, consequently she got injury on her head and thereafter she was treated in Health Center Aliganj. The informant stated the name of the culprits as Kaushal Yadav and Khushbu Devi.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is female having clean antecedent. Moreover, both the parties have entered into an amicable settlement by way of written compromise, and pursuant thereof, the informant has appeared and does not oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

5. The learned P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and conceded the factum of compromise between them.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and further considering the particular fact that both the parties have entered into an amicable settlement and informant has appeared before this court and does not

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oppose the prayer for bail of the anticipatory bail of the petitioners, and further supported the factum of compromise between the parties.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from the date of the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down U/s.482(2) of the B.N.S.S. with further conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be her close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of her bail bonds.
