1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by the accused-petitioner, namely, **Shiv @ Shivanand Kumar Yadav**, in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 158/2025, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 109, 324(4), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.
2. The case of Prosecution in brevity is that the on 02.04.2025 at about 7:30 hour morning, while the informant namely Anil Yadav was returning from the house of Munna Pd. Yadav after taking loan of Rs. 1.50 lakhs for the marriage of his daughter and when reached near Sohjana, then all and sudden the accused persons namely Shiv Yadav and Sankit Yadav along with five unknown persons surrounded his motorcycle and on being queried, the accused abused and assaulted by iron-rod and caused head injury and also snatched Rs. 1,50,000/- and destroyed his mobile.
3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioner that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna, except to it.
4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity for sitting passenger on their vehicle because both are drivers. The petitioner has not got any criminal antecedent. All the alleged sections areailable save and except Section 109 of B.N.S. which is not specific rather the same is round-up and vague. It is, therefore, prayed to grant Anticipatory Bail to the accused-petitioner.
5. On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P. opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.
6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. The has been instituted at the instance of Anil Yadav. The place of occurrence is the road situated at Sohajna Chowk. Para 7, 8, 9 are the statement of witnesses wherein though they supported the case of the informant but made specific

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allegation of assault by iron-rod upon co-accused Sankit Yadav. Para 22 of the CD is the injury report wherein though the final opinion of the expert had not been produced by the police before the Court but on perusal of the injury appears to be minor and not vital. He further reflects that the police in its supervision note found case false against co-accused namely Sankit Yadav. Moreover, as submitted the petitioner is having clean antecedent.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to petitioner's prayer and accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, namely, **Shiv @ Shivanand Kumar Yadav**, is hereby **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and, subject to the conditions that, **one of the bailor should be blood relative of the petitioner and the other should be public servant. Further, the petitioner shall not involve in similar offences.** The petitioner shall also file an affidavit/undertaking with respect to obey the condition as mentioned in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.

8. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
