1. Present application has been moved on behalf of the petitioner for seeking extension of period for seeking regular bail.
2. Heard both sides and perused the record.
3. Perusal of record reflects that anticipatory bail of the petitioner was disposed of vide A.B.A. No. 1651/2023 arising out of Complaint Case No. 243C/2023 vide order dated 04.11.2023 by this court with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the learned court below within three weeks from the date of order and seek regular bail, if so advised. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the petitioner's son namely Pravin Kumar fell seriously ill and was admitted to AIIMS Deoghar on 11.10.2023 and since then he is under treatment, so the petitioner could not appear / surrender before the court below for seeking regular bail. The lapse was not intentional rather it was circumstantial. Hence, it has been prayed to extend the time to appear before the court below for the ends of justice, so that he may appear/surrender before learned court below and seek regular bail.
4. Considering the submission of Ld. counsel of petitioner, this court is of the opinion that it would be in the interest of justice if the prayer for extension of period of surrender of the petitioner is allowed. Accordingly the present petition is allowed subject to the condition that petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 5000/- in Victim Compensation Fund, DLSA, Jamui Civil Courts, Jamui and file the receipt of the same before learned court below at the time of surrender in the court. The petitioner is directed to appear to the court concerned within a period of one week from the date of this order.
5. Accordingly, this application is allowed. Let, a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned in connection with Complaint Case No. 243C/2023 and further O/c is directed to consign the file in record room after due compliance.
