1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S, 2023 filed by accused-petitioners, namely, **1. Deepak Sah 2. Dinesh Sah 3. Bablu Sah 4. Basanti Devi 5. Mukesh Sah 6. Sonu Kumar & 7. Monu Kumar**, in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 192/2026, U/s 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.

2. The case of Prosecution in brevity is that on 10.05.2026 at around 08:10 p.m., when the informant was returning from house of her sister and reached at the grocery shop then the accused name in the F.I.R. came there and started abusing him and on protest assaulted him by means of stick and when the informant called his son then accused Deepak Sah assaulted him by means of sword, due to which sustained head injury and other co-accused persons also assaulted him by means of lathi. It is further alleged that when informant's mother and brother came to save him, they were also assaulted by the accused persons and the accused also snatched Rs. 1,50,000/-.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioners that prior to this bail petition, no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners except this Ld. Court.

4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. Further, submitted that the petitioners are a man of spotless character no any criminal history against the petitioners. Further all the sections are bailable in nature except 109(1) B.N.S., which is not applicable against the petitioners. Both parties belongs to Kaleshwar Sah's family and both parties are uncle and nephew same family member and case has been filed only with intention to get partition of land.

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5. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. On perusal of record it reflects that the the informant and the other witnesses have supported the case as reflects from para 2, 7 & 8 of the case-diary. Further the I.O. has submitted injury report of injured namely Gorelal Sah and Babni Devi. The doctor found head injury and pain and swelling on right forearm on injured Gorelal while pain and abrasion on the body of injured Babni Devi. The injury reports supports the case of informant. Further there is direct and specific allegation against accused namely Deepak Sah and Dinesh Sah of assaulting upon head and hand of the informant. Considering these facts and the specific allegation against the petitioners namely Deepak Sah and Dinesh Sah, this court of the view that these petitioners do not deserve the privileges of pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioners namely **1. Deepak Sah 2. Dinesh Sah** are hereby **rejected**.

7. So far as allegation against the accused-petitioners namely, 3. Bablu Sah 4. Basanti Devi 5. Mukesh Sah 6. Sonu Kumar & 7. Monu Kumar, are concerned, there is general and omnibus allegation against them and as submitted they are carrying clean antecedent and as such this court finds that a lenient approach can be taken with respect to the prayer of this accused-petitioners namely, 3. Bablu Sah 4. Basanti Devi 5. Mukesh Sah 6. Sonu Kumar & 7. Monu Kumar, as to pre-arrest bail.

8. Accordingly accused-petitioners, namely, **3. Bablu Sah 4. Basanti Devi 5. Mukesh Sah 6. Sonu Kumar & 7. Monu Kumar**, are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and subject to the conditions that one of the bailor should be blood relative or co-villagers.

9. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
