1. This Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely **1. Sachin Sah, 2. Santosh Kumar, 3. Muniya Devi**. This bail petition is filed in connection with Gidhour P.S. case No. 100/2026, lodged U/s- 87, 137(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. Copy of bail petition has been earlier supplied to prosecution.

2. The prosecution case in brief is that according to the informant his daughter Dolly Kumari age 19 years use to stay and study at her maternal uncle home on 05.05.2026 Sachin Kumar abducted informant daughter with the intention of marrying her and taken her away. The accused Sachin Kumar called his brother Santosh Kumar Sah and informed him that he had ran away with Dolly Kumari and Dolly Kumari is with him Subsequently Santosh Kumar called the informant from his Mobile phone and informed him that his brother Sachin Kumar is with the informant's daughter. On the written application of informant the present F.I.R was registered.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that besides the instant case no other criminal proceedings and no other bail applications of instant nature has earlier been filed on behalf of the petitioners mentioned hereinabove either before this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent. He has committed no offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case.

4. On the other hand, Learned Add. P.P vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

5. Heard both the Ld. Counsel and peruse the material on record. During argument of the present anticipatory bail application. The victim and the accused were physically present in the court also the informant of this case was also physically present in this court and orally submitted before this court that his daughter has willingly gone along with the petitioner and had married with the petitioner and currently happily living with the petitioner. The victim Dolly Kumari whose age is 19 years has submitted before this court that he willingly married with the petitioner. Thus considering the fact and circumstances of the case, the nature of allegation against the petitioner this court is inclined to grant

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extraordinary relief of the petitioners. Thus the present Anticipatory Bail application for applicants namely **1. Sachin Sah, 2. Santosh Kumar, 3. Muniya Devi** is hereby **allowed**. It is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender of accused petitioners within reasonable time, the aforesaid petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the conditions as laid down in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., and further, with the condition that at least one of the bailors should be close relative or co-villager of the petitioner.

6. The observations in this order are only for the purpose of deciding the present Anticipatory Bail Application and shall not in any manner tantamount to any opinion on the merit of the case and shall not be in any manner affect the investigation/ trial/ other proceedings of the present case which shall be conducted as per law.
