1. A surrender-cum-bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1) Biranchi Yadav, 2) Santu Kumar, and 3) Manti Devi**, who are accused in connection with **Sikandra P.S. Case No.175/2020 U/s. 341, 323, 307, 504, and 506/34 of the I.P.C.** pending before this court vide S.T.No. **337/2020**

2. Heard Sri **Sachidanand Yadav**, the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. Perused the record. It appears that it is a case of mis-use of privilege of bail by the petitioners. It has been submitted that this case was committed to the court of sessions on 20.6.2022, and due to mis-under-standing of date, no pairvi was made in the case on behalf of the petitioners, and lastly, on 20.11.2022 their bail bonds were cancelled and W/A has been issued against them, and when they got knowledge about the case, the petitioners voluntarily surrendered before this court with a prayer to grant them bail. They also undertakes that they will not misuse the privilege of bail in future, and will remain present in the court on the date fixed.

4. The learned P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail but conceded that it is a case of misuse of privilege of bail.

5. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousands) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of this court **subject to the conditions that petitioners will deposit a cost of Rs.1000/-each in Victim Compensation Fund (DLSA), Jamui.**
