BIJU KUMAR SINGH & 2 OTHERS VS. THE STATE OF BIHAR

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners 1. Biju Kumar Singh @ Jagat Bandhu Singh, 2. Deenbandhu Singh and 3. Murari Singh who are apprehending arrest in Jamui P.S. Case No. 251/2025 registered U/s-191(2), 190, 115(2), 110, 74, 303(2) of B.N.S., the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition was filed either in this Id Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna except the present one. The petitioner no. 1 has no criminal antecedent and petitioner no. 2 & 3 have have one criminal case vide Laxmipur P.S Case No. 111/2017. The police did not give notice u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S to the petitioners. The allegations against the petitioners are totally false and concocted. All sections areailable except sections 110 and 303(2) of BNS which are not applicable against the petitioners. Both parties are co-villagers and there is civil dispute between them. As per Id. Counsel the petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding and they are ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to admit the petitioners to anticipatory bail.

The Id. Addl. PP opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of LCR and case diary it is clear that the petitioners are F.I.R. named accused persons. The prosecution case as per written information of Vijay Kumar Singh is that on 09.05.2025 at about 1:15 pm, when he was returning to his house at Ratanpur from Jamui Court after making pairvi in his GR Case No. 1142/15 and as soon as reached the main road 200 yards ahead of Garo Nawada Road Chaiti Durga Temple, Deenbandhu Singh, Murari Singh, Neelkamal Singh, Rajiv Kumar Singh, Neeraj Kumar Singh, Pankaj Kumar Singh, Biju Kumar Singh all surrounded and stopped his motorcycle and Amber Singh ordered to kill and loot him. After that all the named persons with intention to kill, assaulted at his forehead, back, hands, testicles and other parts of the body and injured him and it started bleeding from his forehead and hands. Murari Singh, Deenbandhu Singh and Neelkamal Singh assaulted at his

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forehead and hands with iron rod causing cut and it started bleeding. Rajiv Kumar Singh, Neeraj Kumar Singh and Pankaj Singh with intention to kill, assaulted at his forehead, back, legs, neck and testicles with hockey stick. Biju Kumar Singh and Amber Kumar Singh caught hold of him and assaulted at his head and chest with iron rod rod and injured him. Amber Singh took away his Realme mobile and his purse from his pocket which contained Rs. 10,000 cash. There were five unknown persons also with them. They also misbehaved with his wife Anuradha Singh. The informant in CD para-3 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras 6 and 7 have supported the occurrence. In CD paras-18 and 19 the independent witness have stated that the name of petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case as the petitioners were present in the Court campus from 11.00 AM to 4.00 Pm. In CD para-21 the police has given notice u/s-35(3) of BNSS to the petitioners but the petitioners did not file any bond in furtherance nor availed the benefit of notice u/s-35(3) of BNSS. As per CD para-35 injury report of Vijay Kumar Singh shows (i) Pain in right elbow, Right wrist, Right hand, Left Shoulder, Left Wrist and hand, Pelvis, both ankle and right foot. 2. H/o Altered sensorium, recurrent vomiting, severe headache, convulsion and giddiness due to blunt trauma of head, caused by HBS injury no. 1 is grievous in nature and injury no. 2 is simple in nature. In CD para-45 the SDPO and in CD para-48 the S.P, Jamui has found the case as true for offence u/s-191(2)/190/115(2)/109(1)/303(2) BNS against all FIR named persons but showing Niraj Kumar and Ambar Singh as innocent. As per CD para-42 there is no criminal case against the petitioner. However the Court finds that the co-accused Pankaj, Rajeev Kumar Singh and Neel Kamal Singh were earlier convicted for offence u/s 323 IPC and were sentenced with fine of Rs. 1000/- each in GR No. 1142/2015 decided on 13.11.2025. The independent witnesses in CD para-18 and 19 have told about only Niraj Kumar and Ambar Singh as present in the Court campus who were also found as innocent by the S.P Jamui in his supervision note. The Court finds that there is allegation against these petitioners to have assaulted the injured person. The accused petitioners assaulted at his forehead, back, legs, neck and testicles with hockey and stick with injury no. 1 being grievous in nature. The matter is still under

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investigation. Therefore the petitioners do not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Therefore in view of the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submission tendered by the parties the A.B.P filed on behalf of the petitioners **1. Biju Kumar Singh @ Jagat Bandhu Singh, 2. Deenbandhu Singh and 3. Murari Singh is Rejected.**
