1. Record put up today for hearing on the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, **1. Vijay Rajak @ Digvijay Rajak 2. Ajay Rajak & 3. Manoj Rajak.**

2. Present application has been moved on behalf of the petitioner for seeking extension of period of surrender.

3. Heard both sides and perused the record.

4. Perusal of record reflects that the petitioners were directed to appear before the court below within 4 weeks on 19.01.2026 vide with the Anticipatory Bail Application No. 1772/2025 arising out of Jhajha P.S. Case No. 177/2025 pending in the Court of C.J.M, Jamui. But, it has been argued on behalf of petitioners that due to unavoidable circumstances and for the medical circumstances petitioners went to out of State due to which they could not appear before learned court below and it has been prayed that the period of appearance of the petitioners may kindly be extended, so that they may appear before learned court below.

5. Considering the submission of Ld. counsel of petitioners this court are of the opinion that it would be in the interest of justice if the prayer for extension of period of appearance of the petitioner is allowed. Accordingly the present petition is allowed subject to the condition that petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 1,000/- in Victim Compensation Fund, DLSA, Jamui and file the receipt of the same before learned court below at the time of appearance in the court. The petitioners are directed to appear to the concerned court within a period of ten (10) days from the date of this order.

6. Accordingly, this application is allowed. Let, a copy of this order be sent to the court of C.J.M, Jamui in connection with Jhajha P.S. Case No. 177/2025 and the O/c is directed to consign the file in Record Room after due compliance.
