1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by accused-petitioner, namely, **Kot Tanti**, in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 513/2025, U/s 191(2), 190, 115(2), 126(2), 352, 118(1), 110, 303(2) of B.N.S., is hereby disposed of.
2. The case of Prosecution in brevity is that on 09.09.2025 at around 11:30 a.m., named FIR accused persons armed with deadly weapons came at the purchased land of first informant Rekha Devi and asked for Ashok upon which the informant said that her husband is not at home thereupon the accused started abusing and accused Kot Tanti inflicted rod blow on her head and caused injured. It is further alleged that the accused broken her mongalsutra and even assaulted to Ramesh Kumar Tanti by rod and broken her hand and leg.
3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioner that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna except to it.
4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. Further, the petitioner is a man of spotless character and has got no any criminal history. The benefit of Section 35(3) of B.N.S.S. has not been given to the petitioner by the police. All sections are bailable except Section 110 and 303(2) of B.N.S., which is not applicable in this case. Further, there is case and counter between the parties and the instant case is the counter blast of Jamui P.S. Case No. 512/2025 which has purposely been lodged by the informant to save their guilt skin.
5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional P.P. opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

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6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. There is specific allegation against the petitioner of assault by iron-rod upon the informant and such fact has been supported by the witnesses in their respective statements before the police. Further, Para 34 of the CD, is the injury report of the informant Rekha Devi wherein the concerned doctor found head injury as grievous in nature.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case and the direct and specific allegation of assault against the petitioner, I find that this is not a fit case to grant privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the Anticipatory Bail Petition of the petitioner, namely, **Kot Tanti**, is hereby **Rejected**.
