1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 20.4.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.251/2021 registered for the offence U/s.341, 323, 324, 308 and 504 read with 34 of the I.P.C. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Satyajeet Kumar,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Moim Mian has lodged the instant case by submitting an application before the SHO of Khaira Police Station alleging therein that on 23.7.2021 at about 12.30 P.M.,the petitioner Nayeem Mian was passing electric wire through the roof of the house of informant,and when informant objected, then the petitioner Nayeem Mian started abusing him,and he also assaulted him by means of lathi over left hand of informant,and when wife of informant Hasmuniya khatoon came to save him, then Nayeem Miyan (petitioner) gave lathi blow over her head,and due to which, she received injury over her head,and when father of informant namely Khalil Mian tried to pacify the matter, then he was also assaulted by the petitioner by means of lathi.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is happens to be full brother of the informant having clean antecedent. It is also submitted that due to some family dispute, there was a scuffle, in which, both the parties sustained injury.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the injury inflicted to the informant and his wife are grievous in nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and

further considering the particular fact that both the informant and petitioner are happens to be full brother and he has clean antecedent. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 20.4.2026 and now the investigation against the petitioner is completed, and charge sheet has been submitted against him, and there is no any fresh material has to come in the case.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below **subject to the conditions that one of the bailors of the petitioner must be his close relative, and petitioner shall remain present before the court below on each and every date, failing to appear on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason shall result in cancellation of his bail bonds.**
