GOLAK KODA VS. THE STATE OF BIHAR

This regular bail petition has been filed by petitioner **Golak Koda** who is in custody since 08.05.2026 in connection with Lachhuar P.S. Case No. 73/2025 registered U/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 223, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 121(1), 121(2), 132, 352, 351(2) of B.N.S and Section-3 Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the custody accused has submitted that accused is rotting in jail since 08.05.2026. The regular bail petition was rejected on 22.05.2026 by Miss Medha Manisha J.M Ist Class, Jamui and after that no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of this petitioner in any other Court except the present one. The petitioner has three more cases vide Lachchhuar P.S Case No. 72/2025, Excise Case No. 229/2020 and Excise Case No. 334C2/2019. The police has not given notice u/s-35(3) of BNSS to the petitioner. As per Id. Counsel the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner denies all the allegations what so ever levelled against him. The petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding and he is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Id. Addl.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the LCR and case diary it is clear that on the basis of written information of Vikash Kumar, the Lachhuar P.S. Case No. 73/2025 was registered U/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 223, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 121(1), 121(2), 132, 352, 351(2) of BNS and Section 3 Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, The prosecution case in brief is that on 29.06.2025 at about 12:35 A.M during the course of patrolling the informant along with other police personnel proceeded from PS for arresting of accused Ranjeet Koda, Naresh Koda and Golak Koda in connection with Lachhuar PS Case no.-23/25 and 72/25 respectively, reached at village Korasi and with the help of raiding party members when Naresh Koda was arrested in his house, he started to abuse, with the

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help of co-accused persons and 15-20 unknown persons restored to stone pelting and assaulted on the police party. They were identified by Mahal Chaukidar. The accused persons armed with laathi danda, weapons came and assaulted with intention to commit murder which caused injury to Shyamsundar Kumar Home Guard BHG/470941 and also badly damaged Govt. vehicle Bolero bearing No. BR-01-HP1031 and BR-01-HU-2250. The accused persons committed offence and taking advantage of darkness Golak Koda fled away from the P.O. The informant in his re-statement in CD para-4 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras-5, 6, 7, 17 and 20 have fully supported the prosecution case. The injury report of Shyamsundar Kumar in CD para-54 shows 1. Pain and Swelling at occipital, 2. Bruise on back, 3. Bruise on right arm, 4. Blood from nose, 5. Pain and Swelling at parietal region and 6. Whole Body pain, all injuries are simple in nature. In CD para-80 there is one criminal antecedent against the petitioner. The Court finds that allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith other accused persons assaulted the informant, thus the allegation is found to be general and omnibus with no specific and overt act attributed against the petitioner. The other co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court. The case of petitioner is on similar footing. The petitioner is in custody since 08.05.2026.

Therefore considering the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submissions advanced by both the parties, the custody accused **Golak Koda** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
