This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 20.5.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S.Case No.206/2026 registered for the offence U/s.126(2), 115(2), 117(1), 109(1), 351(2), and 352 read with 3(5) of B.N.S. pending in the court of the C.J.M.,Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Makeswar Prasad Yadav,the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Gorelal Yadav has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Khaira Police Station alleging therein that on 19.5.2026 at 8 a.m.,the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioner abused him when he inquired about his stolen Khanti which was found in possession of the petitioner. It is further alleged that the petitioner abused and co-accused Roshan Yadav struck on the head of the informant, whereby, he got injury on his head, and thereafter, all the accused persons assaulted him by means of stick and lathi.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case. Moreover, both the informant and petitioner are full brother, and there is amicable settlement between them during pendency of this case through a written compromise which has been filed and kept on the record. The informant appeared and does not oppose the prayer for bail of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail but conceded the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that there is no any specific overt act of

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assault alleged against the petitioner, and the entire allegation is general and omnibus in nature. Moreover, the informant is happens to be full brother of the petitioner, and both parties have compromised their case amicably out side of the court.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
