1. This is a regular bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner who is in judicial custody since 28.05.2026 in connection with Jamui P.S.Case No. 254/2026 registered for the offence U/s. 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 324(4), 352, 351(2) of B.N.S. and 27 of Arms Act pending in the court of C.J.M., Jamui.

2. Heard Sri Amit Kumar, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P.for the State.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Sabana Khatoon has lodged the instant case by way of submitting an application before the SHO of Jamui Police Station alleging therein that on 27.05.2026 at 6:00 p.m. when her younger son and brother-in-law namely Jisan and Md. Imtiyaz respectively were making some construction over his roof for smooth drainage of water, then in the mean time, the accused Md. Bholu came there and protested for making the construction. Thereafter, other co-accused persons including the petitioner have also came there having lashed with Iron Rod, Sword and Lathi and started assaulting the son and brother-in-law of the informant. It is specifically alleged that Md. Salim struck on the head of the son of informant by means of iron rod and Md. Samid @ Bablu assaulted to the brother-in-law of the informant by means of lathi on his head, in the mean time, when the daughters of informant came for rescue, then accused Md. Hasim @ Bholu struck on the head of Arfa Parveen by sword and Md. Dablu struck on the head of her another daughter namely Niyati Parveen by means of lathi. The grand son of the informant Md. Aftab Alam was also assaulted by accused Md. Alim. Thereafter, Md. Samid @ Bablu also fired indiscriminately from his rifle

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and accused persons also damaged the C.C.T.V. camera installed in the house of informant and gave threatening for dire consequences if any case will be filed against them.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has clean antecedent. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and no any overt act has been alleged against him. Moreover, in the diary, final injury report of Md. Gabbar , Md. Jisan and Md. Imtiyaz are mentioned and the same are simple in nature. It is also submitted that the petitioner is a student and he has to appear in the NEET Examination, which is re-scheduled to be held on 21.06.2026.

5. The learned P.P.for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and further considering the particular fact that the petitioner is a student having clean antecedent and there is no any overt act has been alleged against him and there is only general and omnibus allegation of assault alleged against him and nature of injuries are simple.

Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
