1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by accused-petitioner, namely, **Ayush Jha @ Sandip Jha**, in connection with Gidhaur P.S. Case No. 149/2024, U/s 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S., is hereby disposed of.
2. The case of Prosecution in brevity is that the informant-Manish Kumar Jha has lodged FIR in Gidhaur P.S. alleging therein that on 16.10.2024, the accused persons namely Umashankar Jha @ Bijay Jha, Pammi Devi, W/o- Umashankar Jha and Ayush Jha, S/o- Umashankar Jha entered into the house of informant and assaulted the mother and brother of informant and committed theft of Rs. 40,000/- (Forty Thousand only), accordingly FIR was lodged by Manish Kumar Jha.
3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioner that no other bail application has been filed on behalf of this accused person in any Court save and except the present one.
4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is no criminal antecedent of the petitioner. Further, there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner. Under Section 303(2) is also not specific rather it is added only to make the offence non-bailable, so far u/s 109(1) B.N.S. is concerned that is non-bailable but the same is not applicable. There is land dispute between the parties and the petitioner Pammi Devi and Umashankar Jha have been granted bail. Further, submitted that the as a matter of fact, it is counter blast of Gidhaur P.S. Case No. 150/24 filed against informant party.
5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional P.P. opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

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6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. On perusal of record, it reflects that there is case and its counter. Further, there is general and composite allegation against the petitioner. Further, the injury report of Rekha Devi is on record wherein only body-ache were found by the doctor while injured Vikash sustained one injury on head of size i.e. $\frac{1}{4}$ cm x $\frac{1}{4}$ cm x $\frac{1}{4}$ cm and one cut on eye of size i.e. $\frac{1}{4}$ cm x $\frac{1}{4}$ cm x $\frac{1}{4}$ cm. Further, the final opinion as to injury of Vikash alleged to sustained on 16.10.2024, it has been stated that the doctor yet not prepared supplementary injury as reflects from para 123 of CD. Further, the injury sustained does not appear to be vital and there is also no repetition of blow on head. Moreover, para 127 of the CD reflects that petitioner is carrying clean antecedent.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to petitioner's prayer and accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, namely, **Ayush Jha @ Sandip Jha**, is hereby **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and, subject to the conditions that, **one of the bailor should be blood relative of the petitioner**. The petitioner shall also file an affidavit/undertaking with respect to obey the condition as mentioned in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.
