1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S, 2023 filed by accused-petitioners, namely, **1. Indradeo Chaudhary 2. Bachhi Devi & 3. Rina Devi**, in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 143/2026, U/s 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 126(2), 191(1), 191(2), 191(3), 351(3), 352 of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is of abusing and assaulting the informant party by means of Rod, Stick etc and thereby caused injury.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioners that save and except the present one, no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed or pending on behalf of the petitioners with regard to the present case either before this Ld. Court or before any other Superior Courts, including the Hon'ble Patna High Court, as informed by the Pairvikar of the petitioners.

4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case by the informant due to quarrel of children and dirty village politics. Further submitted except the present one, no other criminal case has ever been lodged or pending in any Court against the petitioners. Further all sections are bailable except the Sections 118(1) & 118(2) of B.N.S. but in the present case, there is no application of these sections.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor and Ld. Adv. on behalf of informant vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. Perused the record, it reflects that the informant in her re-statement and the

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witnesses in their statement and supported the case as reflects from para 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 21, 22 of the CD. Further para 41 and 52 of the CD is the injury reports of the victims which also supports the case. Further there is direct and specific allegation of assault against the petitioner namely Indradeo Chaudhary. Considering these facts and the specific allegation against the petitioner namely 1. Indradeo Chaudhary, this court of the view that this petitioner do not deserve the privilege of pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner namely **1. Indradeo Chaudhary** is hereby **rejected**.

7. So far as allegation against the accused-petitioners namely, 2. Bachhi Devi & 3. Rina Devi, are concerned, these petitioners are lady and there is general and omnibus allegation against them and as submitted they are carrying clean antecedent and as such this court finds that a lenient approach can be taken with respect to the prayer of this accused-petitioners namely, 2. Bachhi Devi & 3. Rina Devi, as to pre-arrest bail.

8. Accordingly accused-petitioners, namely, **2. Bachhi Devi & 3. Rina Devi**, are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and subject to the conditions that one of the bailor should be blood relative or co-villagers.

9. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
