1. By way of this order the Anticipatory Bail Petition u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by accused-petitioner, namely, **Sanni Paswan @ Saurav Kumar Paswan**, in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 544/2025, U/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 74, 303(2), 351(2), 118(1), 109, 125(A) and 125(B) of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.
2. The allegation against the petitioner is of abusing and assault to the informant.
3. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused-petitioner that no other bail petition either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before this Ld. Court or before the Hon'ble High Court Patna except this bail petition.
4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR rather he has been falsely prosecuted being Bhagina of co-accused Chandan Kumar Paswan, who has lodged Jamui P.S. Case No. 539/25, u/s 191(2), 190, 125(2), 115(2), 18(1), 110, 351 of BNS against the prosecution party, informant Saudagar Paswan and others including Surya Paswan. The petitioner has no prior criminal antecedent. Further, all sections in the FIR are bailable in nature except Section 74, 303(2), 181(1), 109 of BNS, which are super-added only with a view to make the offence of non-bailable. Further, there is inordinate delay of four days in lodging FIR while the distance of alleged place of occurrence for P.S. concern is only 10 km and there is no explanation about delay apart of the above facts. It is further submitted that nine co-accused persons against whom there was specific and graver allegations have been granted

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regular bail by Ld. Court below on 06.11.2025 considering the compromise petition.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional P.P. opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. On perusal of record, it reflects that there is though allegation of abusing against the petitioner but there is no direct allegation of severe assault against the petitioner. It further reflects that the other co-accused have been granted bail by the Ld. Lower Court on the basis of compromise and the other materials available on record. Further, in para 74 of the CD, dated 02.07.2026, it has been mentioned by the I.O. that yet he had not received any injury report of the victim in spite of the fact that the alleged occurrence said to have taken place on 19.09.2025. Further, as submitted the petitioner is carrying clean antecedent and other co-accused have already been granted by the Ld. Court below.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to petitioner's prayer and accordingly, the prayer of pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, namely, **Sanni Paswan @ Saurav Kumar Paswan**, is hereby **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from the order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of like amount each and, subject to the conditions that, **one of the bailor should be blood relative of the petitioner**. The petitioner shall also file an affidavit/undertaking with respect to obey the condition as mentioned in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.
