1. The present Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely, **Niraj Kumar Yadav @ Niraj Yadav**, who is in judicial custody since 20.05.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 210/2026, U/s 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 190(1), 329(3), 324(4), 351(2), 352 of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.
2. The Prosecution case as per FIR in brief is that on 19.05.2026 at about 07:20 p.m., while the informant was at his home then all the accused persons including the petitioner came there and started abusing and on protest, the accused assaulted the informant and others and thereby caused injuries.
3. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna except a bail petition has been filed before the Ld. C.J.M., Jamui who did not consider the prayer of bail and who has been rejected on dated 25.05.2026 as per information given by the petitioner or pairvikar.
4. It is also submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. Further submitted that all sections are bailable except Section 109(1) of B.N.S., which is not applicable against the petitioner. The matter of fact is land dispute, there is case and counter case between the parties and the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody.
5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.
6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. The instant case has been registered on behalf of informant namely Sakindar Yadav. It is alleged that informant, Sri Ram Yadav, Asha Devi, Reena Devi, Pinky Devi sustained injury. Injury report of these victims had been mentioned in para 47 of the CD. Injury report of victim Sakindar Yadav, Sri Ram Yadav, Asha Devi, Pinky Devi are simple in nature while the opinion on injury of Reena Devi is reserved for X-Ray report. Further there is no repetition of blow and only injury on head of Reena Devi i.e. lacerated wound on Lt. parital region of skull size 1"x 1/6"x 1/8" which does not appear to be vital. Further, there is case and its counter and existing land dispute. Further submitted that there is general and composite allegation against the

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petitioner. Further the other co-accused has been granted bail by this court. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 20.05.2026.

7. Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances and mainly considering the custody period of the petitioner, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to the petitioner's prayer of Regular Bail. Accordingly, the Regular Bail Petition of the following, the accused-petitioners, namely, **Niraj Kumar Yadav @ Niraj Yadav**, is hereby **Allowed**. He is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the condition that, one of the bailor must be family member/close relative. Further the petitioner shall not involved himself in similar offences. The petitioner shall also file an affidavit/undertaking with respect to obey the condition as mentioned in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.

8. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
